PARADE ENTRY FEES:

- () **FLOAT** \$575 **\$600 IF PAID AFTER DECEMBER 15**
Includes professionally decorated float, signs for both sides of the float, vehicle to pull float in Parade and transporting of float to and from Parade
- () **CAR/TRUCK** \$25 **\$40 IF PAID AFTER DECEMBER 15**
Organization must have professionally printed sign on both sides of vehicle
- () **HORSES** \$25 **\$40 IF PAID AFTER DECEMBER 15**
Maximum 10 horses in unit (Clean up must be provided by horses' owner)
- () **WALKING UNIT** \$25 **\$40 IF PAID AFTER DECEMBER 15**
Organization must have professionally printed banner identifying group (Participants must be at least 10 years of age.)
- () **SPECIALTY UNITY** \$25 **\$40 IF PAID AFTER DECEMBER 15**
Tow trucks, buses, special design vehicles, antique cars (max. 4 in unit), motorcycles (max. 12 motorcycles in unit) Organization must have professionally printed sign on both sides of vehicle if name is not on vehicle. Lead antique car or motorcycle must have sign.

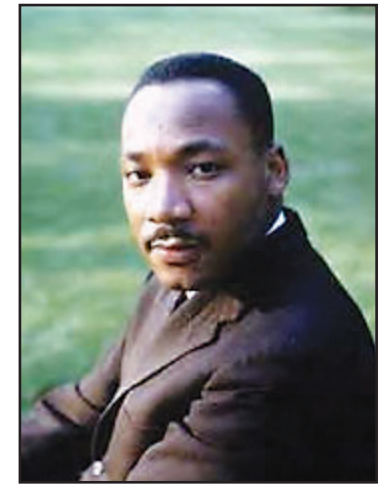
